Trust for Public and Charitable purposes with objects within the meaning of Charitable purpose under the Income Tax Act 1961.

WHEREAS the FOUNDER of the TRUST requested the named hereunder to be Trustees of the Trust alongwith her and they also consented to act as Trustees under these presents.

WHEREAS the FOUNDER of the TRUST has decided to endow a sum of Rs.14,000/- as initial corpus fund and entrust the same with the Trustees for the objects hereinafter mentioned.



NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS.

THE FOUNDER of the TRUST doth hereby create and constitute a public and social trust for the objects detailed hereunder and hereby endow a sum of Rs.14,000/- as initial corpus fund and the Trustees herein do hereby acknowledge the receipt of the same for the objects stated herein after mentioned.

The Funds of the Trust shall further include all sums of money received by the Trustees and accepted by them for the promotion of the objects of the Trust either by donations or from other borrowings and other legal sources of income. All contributions hereafter received shall be as part of the trust property.

(1) NAME OF THE TRUST : Kasiayya Educational Trust

(2) OFFICE OF THE TRUST

The office of the Trust shall be at No.2 Turnbulls Road, Nandanam, Chennai

- (3) OBJECTS
- Grant of Financial Assistance, present, stipends, scholarships to any (a) students, including students engaged in pursuit and study of Vedas, Veda bashyam, Dharma sastras, Vedasastras, Veda agama, epics, srimithi and Indian Classical Philosophical Literatures



- (b) To give financial assistance to institutions undertaking the publication of books, booklets, pamphlets etc. including the related incharge of Veda Sastras and Classical Philosophical Indian Literature on a "NO PROFIT" basis.
- (c) To arrange for medical and for poor feeding camps.
- (d) To give financial assistance to institutions undertaking the publication of books, booklets, pamphlets etc. including the related incharge of Veda Sastras and Classical Philosophical Indian Literature, on a "NO PROFIT" basis.
- (e) To contribute to any other trust approved under 80G of the Income-Tax Act.
- (f) To hold vidwat sadas and conferences, Discussions, symposiums, vakhyarthamas pertaining to Vedas Sastras Philosophical and other subjects.
- (g) To give books and other equipments including stationery to poor students.
- (h) To organize and conduct educational competitions, debates and examinations including vedic nature and distribute prizes.
- (i) To construct and conduct orphanage for the poor.
- (j) To utilize the funds of the Trust for relief of persons affected by flood, fire, accidents, earthquake and war.

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- (k) To construct Community Centre for the purpose of educational discourses, lectures and the like and for use of such building for conducting marriages free of cost for all community without caste or religion or by recovering actual expenditure incurred by the trust.
- (I) To acquire or otherwise take over institutions having objects similar to those of the Trust and which are not run for profit and to maintain, manage, develop, improve and extend the same.
- (m) Organise and run medical camps for the benefit of poor persons of any caste or religion at such places as the Trust may deem fit.
- (n) To construct, undertake, assist or aid in the renovation, repair and maintenance of any temple and other places or Archeological or Historical importance as may be notified by the Central Government under Sec 80G 2B of the Income Tax Act.
- (o) To do all acts and deeds which are lawful as are incidental to or necessary and conducive for the furtherance of the above objects or any of them, provided that the Trust funds shall not be used for such objects as are not acceptable to the Income Tax Authorities for recognition as a Charitable Trust to satisfy the requirements of Section 80-G of the Income Tax Act.
- (p) To provide coaching centres, industrial training centres for self employment scheme.

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- (q) To render all possible help to the infirm, blind, deaf and dumb.
- (r) To assist agricultural ex-servicemen, poor children and to provide rehabilitation centres.
- (s) To provide the best actor, actress, comedian, film Director, Music Director, Villain awards to the persons in the cine field.
- (4) TO PROMOTE AND CARRYOUT THE OBJECTIVES
- (a) Trust is empowered to apply and receive grants and contributions.
- (b) Trust is empowered to purchase, lease, to take licence, or hire movable or immovable property and to raise loans.
- (c) Trust may enter into contract or agreement or any other transaction for achieving the objects
- (d) Trust is empowered to sell, alienate, mortgage, hypothecate the properties funds and assets as the Board may deem fit.
- (e) To appoint persons, agents on such conditions as may be necessary.
- (f) The Trust funds acquired or earned shall be solely utilized for fulfilling the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profits, interests or dividends or otherwise.
- (5) CONSTITUTION OF THE TRUST BOARD

The Trust Board shall consist of seven persons. One Founder President, One Founder Vice President, One Founder Secretary, One Founder Assistant Secretary, One Founder Trustees.

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The quorum of the meeting of the trustees shall be not less than 1/6 of the Trust Board strength from time to time.

(6) ADMINISTRATION

(7.1) POWER OF THE PRESIDENT

President of the Trust shall be executive head of the Trust and his advice shall be taken in all matters pertaining to administration and she shall preside over all meetings and conduct meetings in a democratic manner.

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President of the Trust is the Chief Administrator and after the expiry of period of three years one of the Trustee will be nominated by majority.

(7.2) POWER OF THE VICE PRESIDENT

During the absence of the President the Vice President shall attend, preside and exercise all the powers of the President and at all times assist the President.

After the expiry of three years one of the Trustee will be nominated by majority

(7.3) POWER OF THE SECRETARY

He will manage all the affairs of the Trust, convene Board meeting, incur expenses according to the budget and render accounts thereof in each board meeting, make correspondence, authorise payments to treasurer to set up appoint clerks, registers files etc.,

After the expiry of period of three years one of the Trustee will be nominated by majority.

(7.4) POWER OF THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY

During the absence of the Secretary the Assistant Secretary shall discharge the duties and exercise the powers of the Secretary and shall assist the Secretary at all times.

After the expiry of period of three years one of the Trustee will be nominated by majority.

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(7.5) POWER OF THE TREASURER

Treasurer shall be in charge of accounts and receipts, to get authorization of the Secretary for disbursement maintain accounts, money and arrange for audit, and can kept a maximum of Rs. 5000/- in cash to meet incidental expenses and any amount exceeding Rs.5000/- prior approval of the Founders ought to be obtained.

After the expiry of period of three years one of the Trustee will be nominated by majority.

(8) POWER OF THE FOUNDER

Founder shall hold office at their pleasure and on vacation of office by any one or more on their volition or by death or otherwise the remaining Founders shall co-opt new members and they also shall be entitled to all rights as other Founders.

The Founder shall have full right and power to alter, change, add or remove the nomenclature of the Trust Board, any member of the Trust, admit new Trustee or Trustees, remove Trustee or Trustees by majority and the majority of the Founders vests with all authority to reject or accept any resolution and all Founders have equal rights and liberty as that of all Trustees.

(9) POWER OF TRUSTEES

The Trustee shall hold Trust fund on the following terms.

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The Trustees shall be entitled for reimbursement of all expenses incurredincluding travelling, attending meeting and other miscellaneous expenses and are entitled for remuneration. The Founder and Trustees shall pass resolution by circulation in case of urgency and all resolutions shall be decided by majority. And the Founder and Trustees can make rules for regulating their meetings and may repeal, alter or modify the same.

- (a) To manage the Trust fund, collect, recover, dividends and other income and to pay and discharge out of the income of the Trust fund all expenses and charges.
- (b) To pay utilize the income of the Trust for carrying out the objects of the Trust.
- (c) To apply, discontinue, divert the Trust money to effectuate the objects.
- (d) To receive donations by cash, kind from any person, firm, company, institution, trust.
- (e) To render financial or other aid to any person or institution within the scope of the object on such terms and conditions. And to expend the funds of the Trust may be beneficial for the objects and purposes of the Trust.
- (f) To acquire or exchange agricultural lands, to demolish and reconstruct or to put up superstructure, improve, sell immovable property and to

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take or let on lease or hire or license or to other transfer of any movable or immovable property.

(g) To enter into contracts, borrow money and may repeal add or alter regulations as to the management, affairs, duties, remuneration and to settle out of court compromises and other proceedings, remove and appoint managers, clerks, staff

(10) BANKING ACCOUNTS

The Trust Board shall open one or more Bank Accounts in the name of the Trust. The Bank Accounts shall be opened and money shall be withdrawn by the President and Treasurer jointly. All income and other monies received shall be paid into one or more banks.

(11) ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

The Founder and the Trustees shall keep proper books of accounts and balance sheet as on 31st March every succeeding English Calendar Year and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant or a Firm of Chartered Accountants every year and the Board shall appoint an Auditor every year.

(12) VALUATION

The Founder and the Trustees shall maintain a list of properties acquired and administered and shall vest with the Trust Board.

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(13) ADVISORY BOARD

The Founder and the Trustees may maintain or engage advisors and fix remuneration for their services.

(14) GENERAL FUNCTION

This Trust is irrevocable and if for any reason in the opinion of the Founder Trustees if it falls the net assets shall be handed over to any other public charitable trust as decided by the majority of the Founders. In the event of closure or winding up or dissolution all assets and liabilities shall be transferred to similar trust having similar objects.

The Trust shall invest its income available for investments in specific mode of investments and the income and funds shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust. And any amendment to the instrument or acquisition or alienation of immovable property shall be done only with the prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemption).

The Trust is open to all irrespective of caste, religion etc., and is for charitable purpose and not for profit motive.

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At present the Trust has no immovable property and no activity shall be carried out outside India without prior permission from appropriate authority.
